I write on behalf of Essex Police in response to the application to review the Premises Licence of Street Corner Shop, 11 Market House, Stone Cross, Harlow CM201BL.

Essex Police fully support the review on the grounds of Prevention of Crime & Disorder. The evidence submitted by Trading Standards clearly shows that this objective was not being met.

We also want it noted that these same premises were subject to a review by Trading Standards on 23rd November 2016 for the same reasons which led to a revocation on 19th January 2017. This was subsequently appealed and withdrawn.

On 15th September 2017 a new Premises Licence application was received and this was granted on 18th October 2017.

Essex Police also draw to the attention of the sub-committee that the current Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor Mr Saiwan ALI; lives in the same block of flats as [REDACTED]; the Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor of the Premises Licence revoked in January 2017.

Essex Police believe that the old and new operators are known to each other, but have no evidence to support this.
