At 18:04 hours on Friday, 9th November 2018 Immigration Compliance & Enforcement (ICE) officers attended the Essence of India Restaurant situated at Oasis Hotel, 2 Hart Road, Harlow. They exercised their powers under the Licensing Act 2003 (as amended) to enter the premises.

Upon entry members of staff working in the kitchen were taken to the front of the takeaway. The three members of staff and the manager were then questioned. One of the kitchen workers was found to have no right to work in the UK and detained.

An Illegal Working Civil Penalty Referal Notice was completed and served in respect of the illegal worker.

Essex Police will also produce further documentary or other information in support of this application ahead of the hearing and would ask the authority to take this into account as it may do under Regulation 18 of the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005.

In accordance with paragraph 11.9 of the Statutory Guidance Essex Police may amplify its representation at the subsequent hearing.
