LICENSING ACT 2003 NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER SECTION 34

Notice is hereby given that on the 1st February 2022, Et Group Ltd applied to Harlow Council for a variation of the Premises Licence in respect of premises Chequers Public House, 2 Market Street, Old Harlow, Essex CM17 0AH.

The proposed variation is:-

1. To extend the hours for alcohol sales, the provision of recorded music and entertainment of a similar description to 1100 to 0030 on Fridays and Saturdays.
2. To extend the opening hours on Fridays and Saturdays to 1100 to 0100.
3. To delete condition 3.11 to allow the use of glassware in the garden.
4. To amend condition 3.13 to allow the use of the garden until 2230.
5. To amend condition 3.19 to allow the use of tables and chairs in the garden until 2230.
6. To delete condition 3.0 to allow the performance of live music indoors.
7. To amend condition 3.23 to allow the outside bar to operate until 2200.
