I am applying for this review on behalf of the residents of Three Horseshoes Road, Jerounds, Hawkenbury, Rectory Lane and the surrounding areas on two specific grounds for review:

1. Crime and disorder
2. Prevention of public nuisance

The pub was closed for a long time and re-opened earlier this year under new owners. It has, as per the current licence, a later closing time than nearly all other pubs in Harlow and therefore, when other pubs close many people move to this pub.

Since the re-opening, every weekend I have been contacted by residents in the areas listed above who report extreme anti-social behaviour, drug taking and dealing, fighting, noise nuisance and disturbance. I have attended the pub many times and verify this crime, disorder and public nuisance which is without doubt a regular problem causing misery for the local residents.

We believe this is due to the late licence and as such, we would like the licence reviewed and brought in line with other closing times across the town to stop this crime and disorder and to prevent the public nuisance.

Every weekend, without fail, I am contacted by residents in distress at the crime, anti-social behaviour, public nuisance and disorder, fighting and troubles relating to the late licence of this pub.

It is often the case that during the hours in line with other pubs opening times, there is very little, if any, trouble at the pub. However, when other pubs close and more people travel to this pub, the disorder, fighting, drug dealing, crime and anti-social behaviour begins. This is almost certain to happen every Friday and Saturday evening and the public nuisance, crime and disorder must be dealt with.

The Police have expressed difficulty in dealing with the scale of the issue. They carried out an undercover operation in which no problems arose, but as soon as they left when the pub closed, fighting began on the road and field directly outside the pub.

The pub has made great efforts to deal with the issues, but it is down to the late closing time that the issues are caused with many people travelling to the pub after others shut. They are attracted by the crime and disorder.

I have witnessed many fights and disorder outside the pub either towards the end of the pubs licenced hours or as soon as the pub closes.

Therefore, I believe reviewing the licence to change it in line with the closing times of other pubs, would prevent this crime and disorder and public nuisance.
