My name is Paul carter of 23 Churchgate Street and I would like to strongly object to the licensee of the above property who has made an application for a licence to include a late licence until 12-30am Monday to Saturday As the property will be a sports bar showing live sports and Churchgate being a small village road with very close surrounding properties and no provision made by the licensee for parking on the premises there is a very strong likelihood of noise disturbance and anti social behaviour in the early hours in what we have enjoyed as a peaceful community up until now.
