

Prevention of crime and disorder	✓	I have had to Call the Police myself on at least 3 Occasions due to public nuisance. i) Altercation between 2 groups, ii) Man run over, Ambulance called. iii) Argument between Couple. All incidents interceded by loud vocal and rowdy patrons from Pub waiting for taxis underneath my bedroom window. no thought for residents trying to sleep. Possession of empty beer bottles in arguments.
Public safety	✓	Pub Patrons guilty of leaving mess empty/half empty drink vessels on window ledge, urinating and vomiting on my front door. Constant knocking on my front door causing me to get nervous of someone trying to get in. Once a woman was so drunk she couldn't walk and fell into my door, couldn't get up. Patrons to chequers often Congregate outside forcing pedestrians to walk in road.
Prevention of public nuisance	✓	As above, not once have I witnessed anyone from The Chequers' guiding their Patrons away from residents houses. Rubbish left, never picked up. Standing in groups having very loud conversations. Music resonates down the Street. I work hard to keep my home nice, I do not need these people running it. Very intimidating.
Protection of children from harm	✓	Children who live in this area are prone to being woken up regularly and to run the gamut of all the dangerous rubbish.

Harlow Council Have granted this area Conservation Status - So why ~~it~~ should it be ruined by making this pub into a night club. There are older Residents behind pub they should also be protected from this.
