My family we live at the top of the shop, we are worried if the shop is licensed to sell alcohol about the effects this would have on us and neighbours, as we have set below,

We fear the youth and more people will come to buy alcohol then consume in the area and within the borke of flats we live and they have access to our garden in back where our young children play and under the staircase, we already having to deal with some people who buy energy drinks and sit in our garden.

They will be further littering in the area and in our garden we are already experiece this as a problem, we often get rubbish including gas bottles thrown or left in our garden, sometimes collected by cleaning services and accasionally by us. And also we have a problem of drugs being exchanged infront of the shop, if alcohol is sold in the shop this will make things worse in the area.

They will be additional unpleasantes of unwanted noise and mess and urination after too much has been drunk. We already have the shop opening up in very early hours of the morning(5am - 6am) everyday and locking up late at nite after 8pm. On top of that the alarm for the shop goes off a few times in the nite which is always very hard with young children.

If it were to be granted the alcohol licence this has the potential to spoil the area, atmosphere and more crime where we live and to be a source of further nuisance and aggravation that we already experience to some degree, only a few weeks ago a man was knocked so hard to the ground he was unconscious infront of the shop and poilce and ambulance where called out.
