Whilst in support with Changing Pathways, the number of children open to Social Services has gone down.

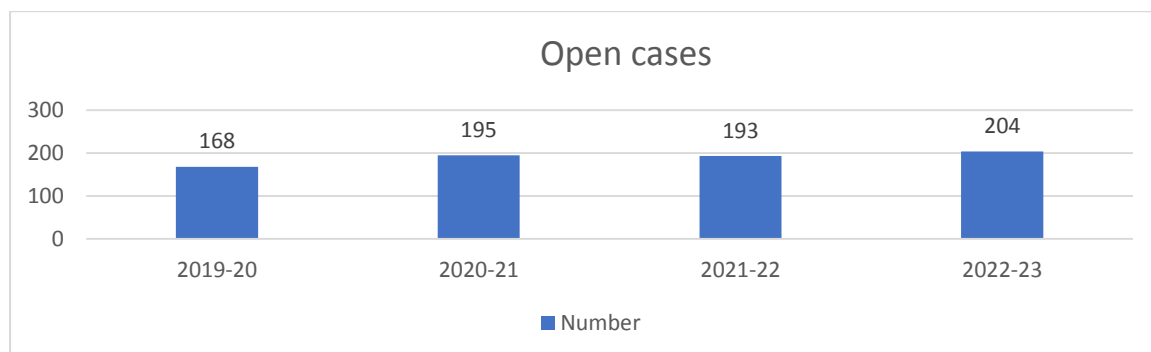
Referrals out

Open cases

The amount of cases open to community services has risen by 21% compared to pre COVID 2019-2020. A 6% increase in open case on last year.



Children open to Social Care

- There is a 4% increase in the percentage of children open to social care compared to pre COVID 2019-2020. Also, a 4% increase when compared to 2021-22
