## Executive Summary

**A** Where individual licensing decisions are required that are not delegated to officers, a Licensing or Regulatory Sub-Committee is constituted to make them. The report shows the decisions for Sub-Committees from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024.

## Background

1. The Licensing Act 2003 requires local authorities to form a Licensing Committee to oversee the Licensing Act remit.

2. The Council's Constitution delegates other Licensing functions to its Regulatory Committee. These include licensing regimes for Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Drivers, tables & chairs on the highway, street trading, scrap metal dealing, sex establishments, gambling premises, charity and house-to-house collections.
3. Where individual regulatory decisions that are not delegated to officers are required, subject to the Constitution a Licensing or Regulatory Sub Committee as appropriate, made up of three members of the Licensing Committee, is constituted to make them.
4. It is therefore possible that the Sub Committee, from time to time, will hear cases relating to any of the matters mentioned above.

### **Issues/Proposals**

5. It is customary for members of the wider Licensing Committee to be kept informed of Sub Committees held and decisions made. The last report of this kind was presented to the Committee in July 2023.
6. The information, as set out in Appendix A to the report, covers the period between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024.
