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FROM THE LEADER

I want Harlow to be the most transformative and impactful local authority in the country. One that truly changes lives - boldly, unapologetically, and with purpose. We are not here to manage decline with a shrug and a spreadsheet - we are here to lead the glorious rebirth of one of Britain's most iconic New Towns.

Harlow has so much going for it.

We led the wave of the New Town revolution, invented fibre optics, the recipe for Baileys, the post-it note, the rotary lawnmower, the cricket scoreboard, the franking machine, Prozac anti-depressants and so much more.

Packed into just ten square miles is the only sculpture town in the world, the first ever highrise residential block, the first ever sports centre and health centre, the biggest social housing landlord in the East of England, nearly 40,000 homes carved into idyllic undulating green space that covers 35% of the district, the country's most extensive off-road cycleway network, inspirational schools, one of the best colleges in the country, multi-billion pound industries both large and small and 100,000 residents.

We are not just part of the UK Innovation Corridor - we are its thumping great heart. And we're growing faster than anywhere else in the country. Within a decade, Harlow will be bigger than major cities like Cambridge.

And yet for too long, we've felt like a lion trapped in a cage. We all share the same frustration - our staff, our partners, our residents - like some supercar blocked in the traffic. We can see the way ahead. We know where we want to go - and we know why we are stuck.

The council has, for too long, lagged behind the ambition of the people it serves. Poor leadership has dimmed the light of a town built on innovation and aspiration. We have been a sleeping giant waiting to be unshackled. But no longer.

We're building Harlow's future.

We are no longer taking decisions because they are easy, but because they are right for our residents both now and in the long-term. And we have already delivered so much. Transformative investment has been secured for the regeneration of our town centre and work is now underway, we're building more council homes than in the past thirty years combined, and our Innovation Park is rising from the ground to deliver jobs and industry-leading facilities. We have ensured that Harlow Homes are for Harlow people, and we have entirely restructured the council and have recruited the very best people in local government.

We have increased our budget by 41% for the year ahead so that every single mission, promise and outcome is fully funded - without raising council tax by a single penny. That's not just leadership. That's belief in what Harlow can be.

This will transform the northern end of the town centre into a vibrant destination for residents and visitors to enjoy leisure, hospitality, and nightlife.

Establish a comprehensive and clear plan to rebuild our housing estates. This will revitalise communities and improving the quality of life for

Programme. This will deliver much-needed social rented homes to meet the growing demand in Harlow and revitalise place where our residents live.





At the heart of our ambitions lies our responsibility to provide safe, high-quality, and well-managed housing for our residents. As the largest social housing landlord per capita in the East of England, with over 9,000 homes, we hold a position of both privilege and responsibility with nearly one third of residents living in one of our homes.

However, our residents are clear that we have underinvested and the judgement from the Regulator of Social Housing has confirmed that we must do better. We accept that challenge without hesitation. We are reshaping our housing services from the ground up, with a renewed focus on quality, accountability, and outcomes.

This is underpinned by the largest housing investment Harlow has ever made; a total budget of more than £136 million this year, up 23% on last year. This includes a revenue budget exceeding £61 million to improve day-to-day operations and a capital programme of over £75 million to modernise and renew our homes.

The outcome? Better homes for families to grow and thrive in; housing that meets the needs of all ages and life stages; faster, more reliable repairs and maintenance; quicker turnaround of empty homes; renewed housing stock; stronger customer service and clearer standards: fewer residents facing homelessness; and Harlow homes for Harlow people.

The work has begun. The expectations are rising.





Enact, in full, our Consumer Standards Improvement Plan.

This will address past compliance failings and restore confidence in our housing services.



Complete our full internal and external stock condition survey of 100% of our homes. This will drive smarter investment, more proactive maintenance, and better-informed decisions - ensuring every home is safe, decent, and fit for the future.



Ensure full compliance with all regulatory and legislative requirements as a social housing landlord. This will embed a culture of accountability and high standards that will safeguard residents, strengthen trust, and position Harlow Council as an exemplary housing provider.



Implement our comprehensive Tenancy Audit programme. This will ensure every council home is visited and inspected at least once a year to better support our tenants.

ensure that Harlow homes are for
Harlow people and create a fairer,
faster, and more transparent
process.



Introduce a new repairs policy and service standards. This will ensure that all repairs are completed within target and are right first time.



Successfully deliver the largest ever Housing Capital Programme. This will realise £75 million of investment to modernise existing homes, build new homes, and enhance communal spaces.



Redesign our approach to housing management. This will ensure we are innovative, effective and truly responsive to the needs of our community.



Implement our Homelessness and Rough Sleeping Strategy (2025–2030). This will reduce homelessness and aim to eliminate rough sleeping in our town.



Optimise tenant and leaseholder engagement. We will foster stronger, more meaningful partnerships with our residents through regular communication, accessible feedback channels, and increased opportunities for involvement in decision-making.



Ensure our council homes are re-let without delay. We will streamline the process and reduce turnaround times for void and empty council homes, ensuring they are quickly and efficiently made available for new tenants.



RENEW our neighbourhoods

Remove unwanted, redundant structures and buildings that blight our neighbourhoods. This will transform forgotten spaces into vibrant, functional assets that benefit residents.

Establish industry leading town centre stewardship and maintenance. This will ensure high-quality management of the town centre which reflects the scale of regeneration.

Continue to reclaim areas of our town that have been blighted by antisocial behaviour. This will be achieved through targeted and effective initiatives such as Clear, Hold, Build and Safe to Go Stow.



Update and strengthen our emergency planning and resilience processes. This will ensure that Harlow Council is fully prepared to respond to any crisis.
